

# Aqua Conserve Controller Check List

1. Settings Screen: Ensure that the proper region is selected.

2. Settings Screen: To reduce overall water usage set the WR% to 90.
3. Time and Date Screen: Ensure that the time and date are correct.
4. Water Days Screen: Set the program to the number of days to run in the *SUMMER*.
5. Start Times Screen: Set the start time for each program.  
Note: If you are experiencing run off please reduce your station run time and add additional start times. This will allow the water to soak into the ground and prevent run off.
6. Station Watering Time Screen: Set each station to the *SUMMER* run time minutes.
7. Run Screen: Press the **More** key and then the **Next** key to run 2 Min Test.  
Ensure that each valve operates correctly.
8. Battery Replacement: Replace the battery every 6 months, or after a long power failure.
9. Temperature Sensor: Ensure the temperature sensor is located away from direct sun light and in a well ventilated outdoor location.
10. Rain Sensor: Ensure the rain sensor is mounted to allow rain to fall on the sensor.
